- 5:10pm-The board will review and application for a 2 lot Subdivision submitted by Richard Drew for the United Church of Winchester. The proposal is to subdivide the 1.6 acre lot, located at 97 Main St map 26 lot 14, with two buildings into one lot of 1.04 acre with the church, and another lot of .56 acre with the parsonage.
- 5:30 pm- The board will review an application for a Boundary Line Adjustment submitted by Gus & Irene Ruth for property located on Jantti Road map 15 lots 2-1 & 1. The applicant proposes to adjust the boundary of the lots to create lots of approximately 11 acres and 113 acres.
- 3) 5:50 pm- The board will review an application for a Boundary Line adjustment submitted by Monadnock Conservancy for the Winchester Learning Center and Lester & Brenda Greenwood. This is for properties on Keene Road, map 30 lots 24 & 25. The proposal is to adjust .78 acre from the Greenwoods to the WLC. This is to create hiking trails, sponsored by the Monadnock Conservancy.
- 4) 6:15pm-The board will review an application for Site Plan Review submitted by Anthony Gobbi, Gi Gi's Realty, LLC, for his property located at 858 Keene Road map 36, lot 1. The request is to operate an auto repair garage as permitted in the Highway Commercial District.

If decisions are not reached, the application(s) will stay on the agenda for the next meeting without further notice. All applications are on file at the town hall and are available to view on the town website at Winchester-nh.gov.
