**Minutes of the
Selectmen Meeting**

Tuesday, November 17, 2020

Board members present: Ben Kilanski, Jack Marsh, Herbert Stephens and Gloria Leustek.

First order of business:

The Chairman opens the meeting at 6:05 pm for a joint work session with the Budget Committee and the Health Agencies to discuss their budgets.

Selectman Stephens makes a motion to approve \$400-Big Brothers Big Sisters. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve \$31,000-Home Health Care and \$6,620-Meals on Wheels. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

Selectman Stephens makes a motion to approve \$5,426-Monadnock Family Services. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

Selectman Kilanski makes a motion to approve \$16,000-Community Kitchen. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 3-0-1.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to not fund Southwest Community Services and bring the line item to \$0. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion fails 2-2. Selectman Kilanski makes a motion to approve \$10,000- Southwest Community Services. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 3-1.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve \$2,500-Child Advocacy and \$1,000-CASA. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

Selectman Stephens makes a motion to approve \$800-Red Cross. Selectman Marsh seconds the motion. Motion fails 2-2.

The Select Board tabled the Hundred nights budget.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve \$500-CVTC. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

Selectman Leustek makes a motion to approve \$1,000-MCVP. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0. Budget Committee discussed the budget and approved \$1,750. Selectman Leustek makes a motion to revisit the original motion. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0. Selectman Kilanski makes a motion to approve \$1,750- MCVP. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. Motion passes 4-0.

The Board of Selectmen took a 10-minute recess at 7:56pm.

Fifth order of business: Nonpublic under RSA 91-A:3II (a)(b)(c)(d)(e)

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to enter nonpublic session under e. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. The motion carries 4-0. A roll call vote was taken, and members vote "yes" individually, and the board convenes in non-public at 8:06pm.

Sixth order of business: Adjournment

The board reconvenes in public session at 9:30pm.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to seal the minutes under e. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. A roll call vote was taken, and members vote "yes" individually, the motion carries 4-0.


Selectman Stephens makes a motion to adjourn at 9:31pm. Selectman Leustek seconds the motion. The motion carries 4-0.
