**Minutes of the
Selectmen Meeting**

Board members present: Jack Marsh, Herbert Stephens, and James Rokes Sr.

First order of business: Minutes

The Chairman opens the meeting at 6:30 pm.

The board reviews the minutes of 4-7-21 and 4/1/21 for approval. Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve the minutes. Selectman Rokes seconds the motion. The motion carries 3-0.

Second order of business: New Business

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve the water abatement for map 5 lot 108-\$26.78, map 34 lot 33-\$50.00 & map 34 lot 18-\$50.00. Selectman Rokes seconds the motion. The motion carries 3-0.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to approve a timber tax for map 1 lot 17 in the amount of \$384.47. Selectman Rokes seconds the motion. The motion carries 3-0.

Theresa Sepe asked the Select Board and School Boards to have a conversation on how Election Day will work at the school during drop off/pick up times for the safety of the kids. Lindseigh Picard stated that the school will have a remote learning day on Election Day, May 11th.

Natalie Quevedo asked the board to approve a scrap dumpster for the town clean-up day, Sat April 24th. Selectman Rokes made a motion to approve the scrap dumpster. Selectman Stephens seconds the motion. The motion carries 3-0. Natalie also asked if the board would consider having the clean-up day twice a year spring & fall. The board agrees. Selectman Marsh would like to see free/no charge week at the Transfer Station. This way people could dispose of items at no charge, and we might not find the items on the side of the roads.

Selectman Marsh makes a motion to enter nonpublic session under "b & c". Selectman Rokes seconds the motion. The motion carries 3-0. A roll call vote was taken, and members vote "yes" individually, and the board convenes in non-public at 6:45pm.

The board reconvenes in public session at 7:10pm.


The board hired Elizabeth Guyette to the Ambulance Dept.
