

April 20th 2023 WCC meeting minutes

Meeting was called to order at 7:04PM.

Minutes for March regular and special meeting minutes were reviewed. Joe made a motion to approve. John seconded, motion passed.

Earth Day:

- Nat showed copy of the sign up form that volunteers will sign which included if want to receive a WCC newsletter in the future. She has 42 laminated tags for volunteers to show.
- Mim made a motion to approve up to \$100.00 for tires. John seconded. Motion passed.
- WCC made a decision to reach out to entities to participate much earlier next year.

- Discussed buying safety vests next year.
- Highway will pick up bags on Monday.
- Joe made a motion to donate any left over food to an appropriate group. Mim seconded. Motion passed. Nat said will cook for Access kids.

Treasurer's Report:

Mim reported that we were over budget by \$401.61 for supplies and expenses. (copy on file)

Mim presented an invoice for Dick Drew of \$225.00 for survey. Mim made a motion to pay. John seconded. Motion passed.

Nat presented invoice for \$80.00 for grabbers and \$31.00 for gloves to be part of money already approved for Earth day.

New Business:

Mim brought a concern to the WCC of individuals attempting to access town land across from her home. When their attempt failed they came back with more people and a four wheeler. Mim spoke to them but they accessed the property in four wheelers. WCC will look into the matter and discussed posting signage and place barriers but will finalize plans at next meeting.

Nat stated that she had spoken with Jim and Karey and that WCC will now receive documents that WCC should review..

WCC reviewed Dick Drew's survey of Ashuelot Street property. Gus disagreed with one

Mim will draft the letter.

Bonnie will put on the agenda for next meeting to discuss the moved pins.

Jones Culvert Wetland Permit Amendment:

WCC reviewed. There were no comments. Nat stated that ARLAC had no comments. Mim made a motion to state that WCC had no comments. John seconded. Motion passed.

Nat stated that she had received comments from WCC on the Ashuelot Corridor Management Plan and she would submit the report tomorrow.
