

September 2020 Winchester Conservation Commission Meeting Minutes

Musterfield Park:

Ten (10) hardwood trees will be planted in the spring, chosen to be able to grow in sandy soil. The trees will need to be watered every week until the ground freezes. Gus purchased a 200' hose and frost free hydrant. An invoice has been submitted to Amy.

Cole Pavilion:

The posts need to be resealed. Mim made a motion to purchase two gallons of sealer. Bonnie seconded the motion. Motion passed

There are two trees down. Paul volunteered to take care of the downed trees.

Forest Lake Circle:
