

**RED Committee Minutes**

**Meeting called to order** 6:01 by Jason

**Minutes** – We approved the minutes from 1/12. **Motion made by Pattie. Second by Devon. Approved 6-0.**

**Financial Report** – Jason dropped some papers off for Lola. Lola will sign and get it to Karey.

**Music in the Park** – Still waiting to hear back from bands. We'll return outdoors for the new season starting in mid-June (June 10<sup>th</sup> – starting with a patriotic theme for Flag day) and go through mid-August. Continue to think of any bands we might like to invite.

**Farmers' Market** – When should we open? Lola will reach out to Hinsdale and Keene markets to inquire on what their plans are for start dates. We will wait until we can be outdoors. Normally we would move outdoors in the beginning of June. Perhaps this year we plan to open up outdoors in May – weather dependent. Any plans for a Food Festival this year are TBD. If we can't have the formal food festival, maybe we can try to do some sort of kick-off event for the first day of the market. We can also plan to run the town-wide clean up simultaneously. Think about start date, activities, first day kick-off event.

**Crosswalk Painting** – Mike not in attendance but he told Jason that he spoke with Dale and it appears we can use the sprayer. We will need police detail for the day. Paint half the crosswalk and let it dry, then paint other half and let that dry – will need to do it this way to allow for traffic flow. Maybe a Sunday afternoon. Dale has keyboard thick plastic stencils. Could we include something additional in the middle of the intersection? Lola can get the original artist's contact info if we need a new stencil made.

**Pole Banners** – Order has been placed and will be shipped when they're done. Jason is working on getting them paid – Bulldog said there's no rush on payment. We should evaluate existing banners when we put new ones up for any that need to come down or be replaced – i.e. Should Mt. Pisgah Diner stay up or come down? All of the Richmond Rd. poles should get the new banners and we'll decide on placement for the remainders (i.e. Keep new and old banners separate or intermixed down Rt. 10?)

**Town Concerns** – New owners of Mt. Pisgah Diner have been renovating – gutted the inside and has all new booths and countertops. Lola mentioned an online petition circulating for those who request that the school and town deliberatives are postponed due to covid-19 safety concerns. Gloria stated that she is 99% sure that the meetings will be postponed – more to come in this week's select board and school board meetings.


