**Right-to-Know E-Meeting Checklist** - Jason went over the checklist and took roll call.

**Minutes** – We approved the minutes from 2/23. Motion made by Mike. Second by Jeanne. Approved 5-0.

**Guest Speaker on behalf of the Rail Trail Committee** – Margaret never joined the meeting.

**Financial Report** – Group needs to approve reimbursement to Gloria \$196.70 for the five year domain registration extension for winchesterfarmersmarketnh.com and winchesterfarmersmarketnh.org Motion made by Pattie, second by Mike, Approved 5-0.

**Music in the Park** – Steve Caddy Jazz Trio added to the calendar for July 22. We still need three more bands. Gloria asked beforehand about vendors – the Lions Club is interested in vending food and drink again and doing a chair raffle. Jason will talk to Margaret about approval or any rules/guidelines and report back next meeting. Anticipate that food should probably be pre-packaged. We'll put out donation cans again this year as well.

**Farmers' Market** – ELMCC hadn't yet decided on a date for the 5K, but it's probable that they will choose May 8<sup>th</sup> because the week leading up to May 1<sup>st</sup> is a school vacation week. Jason has been getting a lot of inquiries from vendors, so the group decided to officially decide on May 8<sup>th</sup> as our opening date, weather dependent.

**Food Festival** – Nothing new to report.

**Town Wide Clean Up** – Nothing new to report.

**Crosswalk Painting** – Mike forgot to talk to Dale; he will follow up before next meeting. Jason still also needs to look into stencil options. Lola spoke with Jess at the ELMCC and determined that the crosswalk painting cannot happen the same day as the 5K due to runners passing through multiple crosswalks that we'll be painting. We can still try to coincide our other events with the 5K though (ie. FM opening day & town-wide cleanup). Lola will follow up Jess at ELMCC about needing a permit from the state for closing Rt 10 and process hiring a cop.

**Pole Banners** – Weather is almost cooperative, so we'll wait a few more weeks to get rid of snow and mud. Potential date to go out as a group - a weekday between 9am-10am the week of April 5<sup>th</sup>.

**Town Concerns** – n/a


