Jeanne submitted a check for \$150 from the Tigan family for music in the park. Jason shared that The learning center sent a \$75 check for music in the park.

**Music in the Park:** Mike has taken over the responsibility of Music in the Park for Jason. Mike is introducing the bands, selling 50/50 raffle tickets. The Lions are participating this year by selling snacks every week. Attendance has been good. Jason was approached by The Arlington Inn about having "ready to go" dinners made for patrons of Music in the Park a portion of the sale of the dinners would go to Music in the Park. J&J Trailers will be providing a brand new trailer to have the bands set up on while they play their music.

**Farmers Market:** Jason shared that the market vendors are now organized so that they are lined up all along Main St. This gives them more of a visual presence and everyone is happy with the new layout. Vendors have started making "live" FB feeds to introduce vendors and to see who is at the market and other activities that may be happening. They plan to do this every week or as much as possible. **Pole Banners:** Jason shared that he gave ripped banners that were taken down to Ruth Juslin, who has repaired them free of charge. The repaired banners will be rehung, have scheduled Sunday July 3rd to hang banners. Will meet at Arlington in for breakfast first, weather permitting.


