

## RED Committee Minutes

7/8/2020

**Meeting called to order** 6:06 by Jason

**Present:** Jason Koerber (Chair), Lola Bobrowski (Secretary), Jeanne VanPatten, Devon Snikeris, Gloria Leustek (Selectman's Representative), Michael Faulkner

**Excused:** Denis V. Murphy (Co-Chair), Patricia Dixe

**Minutes** - We approved the minutes from 6/24. **Motion made** by Devon. Seconded by Jeanne.

**Approved 4-0.** Gloria abstained. Michael came in late and missed this vote.

**Financial Report** - \$1500 for music in the park. \$330 for the farmers' market went into the bank on 7/2. \$275 donated by NE Soils & Sitework and to be deposited this week.

**Farmers Market** – Total of five full-time vendors. Other than that, the market is going well. New hours are working out well. Website and Facebook need to be updated with the new hours.

**Music in the Park** – Tomorrow night will be the first 2020 concert, after two bands canceled last week. We need to requisition checks for these bands. To get the first two bands paid, Jason proposed paying for the first two bands out of his pocket. **Motion for Jason to pay out of pocket and be reimbursed by the RED Committee** by Gloria, **Second** by Michael. **Approved 6-0.** We'll get the paperwork in place to pay the rest of the groups by week 3. Jason will live stream again this year. No trailer so the groups can spread out. Face mask/social distancing signage will be put out. Let's see how the donation cans do and discuss 50/50 at the next meeting.

**Bridge Dinner** – It's still looking like we should cancel. **Motion to cancel the 2020 Bridge Dinner** by Devon. **Second** by Lola. **Approved 6-0.** Jeanne shared some numbers about table options. She'll bring the catalog to share with everyone at the next meeting to discuss for future years. Gloria recommended we do a warrant article to buy the tables – the time for that is approaching soon.

**Pole Banners** – Bulldog quote for 25 banners would be \$75 each including the hardware. We'll charge \$150 – which is \$75 less than the last time around. Anyone can purchase one - business, resident, family, in memory of, etc, as long as they are from Winchester. Devon started to compile information for a form and is seeking feedback from the group. Invoice for the 6 sets of hardware that Devon purchased came to \$216. Additional straps can be purchased from the hardware store. Devon will contact Eversource to get permission on additional poles we can use in town. We received a lot of interest from the announcement put out on Facebook. We'll offer additional options for custom photos on the flags for an extra \$25 and include that on the form. Everyone should share feedback on the form so we can finalize a draft by next meeting.

**Town Concerns/New Business** – There is talk about painting the crosswalks. The town has the stencil but hasn't done anything after numerous requests from people in town. We also talked about doing something in lieu of the bridge dinner like painting the bridge, walk thru art gallery for a day – let's mull this over until next meeting.


**Motion to adjourn** made by Lola, second by Jeanne. Approved 5-0. Gloria left the meeting early.
